



## **Tyger River Park – FAQ**

### **Are pets allowed inside the park?**

No. However, service animals are allowed.

### **What happens during inclement weather (lightning)?**

Tyger River Park is equipped with the ThorGuard lightning detection system. If lightning is detected within in a 10-12 mile radius of the park, an alarm will sound once and patrons will be informed and expected to take shelter immediately. All games and/or events can resume once the ThorGuard system alarm has sounded three (3) times providing the all clear signal.

### **Are fields available for rental?**

### **Are grills allowed inside the park?**

No.

### **Can I park my camper overnight?**

No overnight campers are allowed within the park after operating hours. We are happy to recommend our local campground, [Pine Ridge Campground](#).

### **Are coolers permitted?**

Yes.

### **Are there ATM machines located at the park?**

No. However, your debit or credit card may be used at all concession areas. Also, there are several banks located within a 5 mile radius of the park.

### **When is the observation tower open?**

The observation tower is open during large tournaments and/or events when weather permits and staff are available.

### **When is the splash pad open?**

The splash pad is open from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m., Memorial Day to Labor Day.



**Can I be transported by golf cart if I have a disability?**

Spartanburg County employees are prohibited from transporting patrons. However, wheel chairs are available for use at each pod and at the clubhouse. Park patrons may sign-out a wheelchair for use while at the facility.

**Can I bring a bike, scooter, skateboard or other wheeled apparatus inside the park?**

Bikes, scooters, skateboards and other wheeled apparatus are allowed on the perimeter of the park, but are not allowed in the athletic pods, playground areas or splash pad.

**Where are the designated tent areas?**

Tents are allowed in any grassed common area not utilized by Parks personnel or contractors. However, we ask that all tent legs and awnings do not cover, protrude, or stick out over the sidewalks. All tents are required to be supervised and secured at all times for safety concerns.

**Do you have a lost and found?**

Yes. Most lost and found items will be held, for three weeks, at the clubhouse. For assistance, please see park staff.
